The ePortfolio

What is an ePortfolio?

- An electronic portfolio is a personal website created to represent you and assist the College in evaluating your learning.
- ePortfolios are meant to be active, evolving spaces showcasing personal, professional, and academic growth.
- ePortfolios are becoming the new standard for students and professionals that include examples (artifacts) of skills and achievements, as well as an insightful element (rationale) to portray an individual via a digital presence.
- An ePortfolio provides for reflective learning and can assist in setting career, educational, and personal goals.

What are degree level outcomes?

- Degree level outcomes are those statements in the college catalogue about what you are expected to have learned before you graduate. These are called program learning outcomes.
- Most often, the statements start with, “The student will be able to...”

How do I find my degree level outcomes? ⁴

- First, check with your advisor or the Registrar about what year you were enrolled at the College. This is your catalogue year.
- In your catalogue, you will look for the description about your respective degree: The Associate, the Bachelor's or the Master's.
- Look for the statement: “The student will be able to...”

Who needs to complete an ePortfolio?

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All students who want to earn a degree from ICCI must complete an ePortfolio.

I don't know what to do? How do I get started?

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Look for emails and announcements inviting you to attend a workshop on how to complete your ePortfolio.

What if I don't know a lot about technology?

- You don't have to build the site. The platform will be set up for you.
- If you can post to Facebook, then completing your ePortfolio will be easy.

But I have all A's and B's in all my classes. Do I still need an ePortfolio?

- Grades are not direct measures of your learning gains. They are indirect measures.
- The actual documentation that shows you achieved the degree level competency is the actual graded work you did in class. This is why we need to see the work that has been evaluated by your instructor

When do I start working on my ePortfolio? ⁹

- The Class of 2015 will pioneer the project as part of their preparation to be certified for graduation in February 2016.
- This gives the Class of 2015 about a year from now to complete its ePortfolios
